

# Payday and Auto Title Lending in Texas

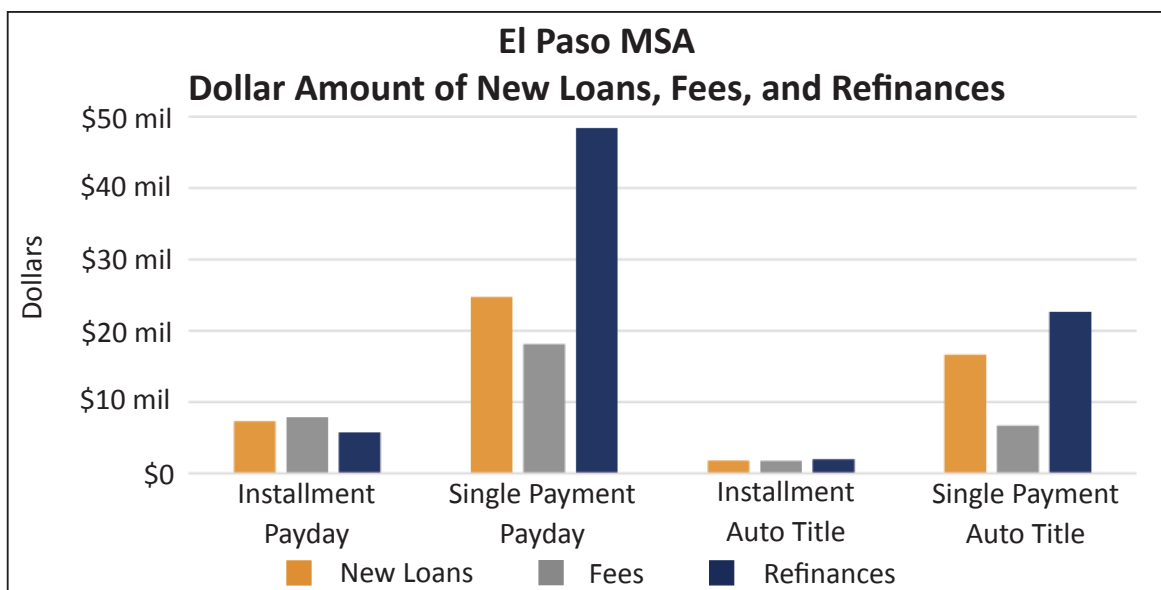

### Short-Term Loans Lead to Long-Term Debt

Payday and auto title businesses in Texas offer two main loan types: single payment loans, due in full in 2 weeks or 1 month, and installment loans, due in a series of payments over a period of up to 6 months. Longer loan terms mean installment loans have fewer refinances, but even higher fees. The 2012 data does not report quarterly data on installment loan products at the local level, making it difficult to capture rate and refinance information for those products.

- **In the El Paso MSA, refinances make up 60% of single payment loan transactions.** Every quarter, 59% of payday loan borrowers and 38% of auto title borrowers refinance their loans.
- **For borrowers who refinance, a two-week payday loan lasts nearly 3 months on average, and a 30-day auto title loan lasts nearly 7 months.** With no limits on refinances, these loans can extend indefinitely with mounting fees and no built-in principal repayment.
- **Average APRs for payday and auto title loans in the El Paso MSA range from 253% to 500%** (see table on back).

## Single Payment Payday Loans Dominate Market

Single payment payday loans make up the vast majority of all loan types throughout the El Paso MSA, making up 57% of total dollars lent (loans and refinances) and 53% of total fees. These loans also have the highest percent of borrowers who refinance, at 58.89%, with an average of 4.81 refinances for borrowers who refinance, indicating that these loans are difficult for borrowers to pay off.
